Arashiyama: Arashiyama is located in west of Kyoto City. It is famous with its rice field & bamboo forest. At the foot of Mt.Arashiyama, we can find Togetsu-kyo Bridge across the Hozu-gawa River which often reflects the beauty of the historical spot.

Todaiji Temple: Behold the world's largest bronze statue, Great Statue of Buddha. Its height is 14.8m (49.1 ft) which was required nearly 10 years in the making and over 3,000 metal plates.

Nara Park: Interact with over 1,200 wild deer that are roaming in the park, considered sacred messengers of Shinto gods according to the local folklore.
