# Day 1 Kuala Lumpur Zagreb (140km) Ljubljana (Dinner)

### Ljubljana City Tour

- Walking tour of Ljubljana Castle.

#### **Bled Tour**

- View of white church on an island in the centre of an emerald glacial lake is the symbol of Bled, a romantic alpine resort.
- Enjoy a pleasant trip in a gondola-type boat called a **pletna** to the island and spend some time at this peaceful sanctuary.
- Entrance to **St Maria Church** and **Bled Castle**, the oldest in Slovenia which stands on a steep cliff above Lake Bled.



# Day 4 Bled (100km) Postojna Caves (350km) Zadar (Breakfast / Lunch / Dini

### Postojna Caves Tour

- Guided tour of Slovenia's Postojna Caves, Europe's most extensive and renowned caves with a 20km labyrinth of subterranean passages, galleries and chambers, filled with fantastic stalagmites, stalactites and other rock formations.
- Take a ride on a cave train to marvel at the size and splendour of this glorious underground world.

## Day 5 Zadar (165km) Split (230km) Dubrovnik (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

### **Split Tour**

- Entrance to **Diocletian's Palace**, built by the Roman Emperor Diocletian in the 4th century.
- Walking tour include Golden and Silver Gates,
   Jupiter's Temple and the Cathedral.
- Walking tour around the Old Town area, its narrow streets barely touched by modernity.
- Drive along the **Dalmatian Coast** to Dubrovnik.

#### **Dubrovnik City Tour**

- Entrance to the Rector's Palace, built in harmonious Gothic and Renaissance styles and to the Top of the City Walls for an unforgettable walk along 80 foot high walls.
- Walking tour includes the **Bell Tower Clock**, **Orlando's Column** and **Sponza Palace**.
